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ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract Structure

Abstracts should be structured under the following headings:

Background/Introduction | Objectives | Materials & Methods | Results | Conclusion

Formatting Requirements

- **Word limit:** Maximum **250–300 words**
- **Language:** English
- **Title:** Concise, informative, and relevant to the research
- **Keywords:** 3–5 keywords
- **Font:** Times New Roman, 12 pt
- **Authors:** Full names of all authors with institutional affiliations
- **Presenting author:** Must be clearly identified
- Tables, figures, references, and extensive abbreviations should be avoided unless specifically permitted.
- Abstracts should contain **actual results and meaningful conclusions** wherever applicable.

Eligibility

- The abstract should represent **original scientific work**.
- The presenting author must be a registered conference participant.
- Ethics approval is required as necessary.
- Plagiarized or previously published work may be rejected or withdrawn from the conference.

PRESENTATION CATEGORIES

Accepted abstracts may be considered for:

Poster Presentation

Selected abstracts will be presented as posters during the designated poster session.

Poster Competition

Eligible posters may participate in the **Best Poster Competition** and will be evaluated by an expert panel based on scientific quality, originality, presentation, clarity, and significance.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. General Requirements

- Abstracts must present **original scientific work** that has not been previously published or presented, unless otherwise permitted by the Scientific Committee.
- The abstract should be relevant to the **theme and scientific scope of the conference**.
- Each participant may submit **one abstract** (maximum) as a presenting author.
- Abstracts must be submitted in **English** through the designated online submission system/email before the specified deadline.
- Abstracts submitted after the deadline may not be considered.

2. Abstract Format

The abstract should be concise, clear, and scientifically structured.

Recommended structure:

- **Title**
- **Authors**
- **Affiliations**
- **Background/Introduction**
- **Objectives**
- **Materials and Methods**
- **Results**
- **Conclusion**
- **Keywords**

3. Formatting Requirements

- **Word limit:** Maximum **250–300 words** (excluding title, authors, affiliations, and keywords).
- **Title:** Concise and informative; avoid unnecessary abbreviations.
- **Font:** Times New Roman, 12 pt.
- **Line spacing:** 1.0 or as specified by the organizing committee.

- **Keywords:** Provide **3–5 keywords**.
- Avoid tables, figures, graphs, references, and citations within the abstract unless specifically permitted.
- Use standard scientific abbreviations. Define an abbreviation at its first appearance.

4. Results

- Abstracts should preferably include **actual results and relevant data**.
- Statements such as “results will be discussed” or “results are expected” should be avoided.
- Numerical data should be presented clearly and accurately where applicable.

5. Ethical Considerations

- Research involving human participants, animals, or sensitive data must comply with applicable ethical standards.
- Ethical approval/reference number should be mentioned where appropriate.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring that the submitted work complies with institutional and ethical requirements.

6. Author Information

Please provide:

- Full name of the presenting author
- Names of all co-authors
- Institutional affiliations
- Department/institution
- Email address of the presenting author
- Contact number, if required

The **presenting author should be clearly identified**.

7. Review and Acceptance

- All submitted abstracts will undergo review by the **Scientific Committee/Review Panel**.
- Abstracts may be accepted for:
 - **Poster Presentation**

- **Poster Competition**, where applicable
- The decision of the Scientific Committee will be final.
- Authors will be notified of acceptance/rejection by **5th September, 2026**.

8. Submission Checklist

Before submitting, authors should ensure that:

- ☐ The abstract is within the specified word limit.
- ☐ The title accurately reflects the research.
- ☐ All authors and affiliations are correctly listed.
- ☐ The abstract contains clear objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.
- ☐ Ethical approval is stated where applicable.
- ☐ The presenting author is identified.
- ☐ The abstract has been proofread for grammar and spelling.
- ☐ The submission is made before the deadline.

Note: Submission of an abstract implies that the presenting author agrees to present the work at the conference if the abstract is accepted.
